4. **Treasurer's Report and Accounts for the year ended 30th April 2021**
5. **COVID-19:** The options for starting the 2021/22 season will be dictated by the continuing advice from the Government and the ECB. Assuming that Places Leisure ("PL") re-opens for cricket, the season will start on Sunday 5th September 2021.

There is one outstanding matter from the 2019/20 season: deciding the Men's Division One Champions. When Old Tauntonians & Romsey A (155 points) and Burrige A (152 points), first play each other in the 2021/22 season, the points gained in that match will be added to their 2019/20 points tally, to decide the 2019/20 champions, as well as counting towards their respective points in the 2021/22 season. That champion team will enter the 2021/22 regional championship.
6. **Fees and Charges for the 2021/22 season only:** Recognising the effect of COVID-19, the Committee proposes:
 - i. To charge £30 for Adult matches (previously £33), and £12 (previously £16.50) for Junior matches.
 - ii. The £30/£15 entry fees for Adult teams and £10/£5 for Junior teams (including Under 17's). Both are reductions from 2019/20.
7. **New Umpires and Scorers Needed:** All clubs in the League are requested to be proactive in recruiting and training new umpires and scorers to spread the load. For training, please contact Jon Leckie: 01264 781361 or 07796 450948, E-Mail: jonleckie@talk21.com.

The League will endeavour to run a greater number of regular sessions orientated specifically to scoring indoor cricket. These proved successful in the 2019/20 season.
8. **Discipline:** As per the Minutes of the 2020 AGM everyone is reminded that they play a vital part of the indoor cricket experience and we do not want any disciplinary issues to be a cause for discouraging anyone's participation in the game of cricket, as players, scorers, umpires, and spectators.
9. **Penalties:** Whilst the League applied a grace period during the 2019/20 season with respect to newly introduced penalties related to scoresheet submissions, many of the same clubs/teams still fell foul of more established regulations, where some simple steps would avoid them e.g. submitting a team sheet.
